The gate attendant is likely the first and last person you will see when visiting the landfill. They are there to help you with your landfill experience and will give you directions on where to dispose of your items.



The public drop off site is easily accessed via paved road inside the Landfill gate. Containers for garbage, yard waste and demolition can be found at the drop off site. Tires, batteries, and scrap metal can also be unloaded here. Mulch, wood-chips, and compost are available free of charge if you load them yourself (when available).

## Funding for the DMC Regional Landfill....

### Taxes ≠ Landfill funding

One of the biggest, if not the biggest, misconceptions about the landfill, and the DMC Regional Waste Commission, is that we are taxpayer funded. Simply stated, there are no tax dollars from any resident that provide funding for the landfill or the DMC Regional Waste Commission. No tax revenue has gone to fund the landfill in over 20 years. During the last several years of county ownership, it was operated as an enterprise fund (i.e. disposal fees).

### Tipping fees = Landfill funding

The DMC Regional Landfill is funded by one source...customer tipping fees. Selected tipping fees:

Trash- \$32/ton (\$5.00 minimum)

Brush (smaller than 8" diameter) and wood (pallets, clean lumber)- \$24.00/ton (no minimum)

Information on other tipping fees can be obtained by contacting the landfill.

## Landfill Services

Grass clippings and leaves, are accepted free of charge and used in making compost.



Compost and woodchips are free (when available) if you load or \$5 per pick-up if we load.

The HazChem Center of Southeast Iowa is located just inside the DMC Regional Landfill. The HazChem Center is your resource for responsible disposal of household hazardous waste items such as oil based paints, household chemicals, pesticides, and herbicides

## Landfill Policies

- \*HOURS OF OPERATION-  
Monday-Friday 8am-4pm &  
Saturdays 8am-Noon
- \*All truck beds and trailers must be securely covered or be subject to a \$10 surcharge.
- \*Please read signs. Surcharges may apply for incorrect disposal of materials into wrong containers.
- \*Cash or check only. No credit or debit cards accepted. Credit available to qualified businesses.
- \*\$20 fee for all returned checks. After receipt of dishonored check, person or business will not be permitted to write additional checks.
